<p>Course Description Eynsham 10 Miles Start on the B4449 132 yards east of the traffic lights at the junction with the A415, three yards before the road sign "Traffic Lights 130 yds" on the opposite side of the road and just east of the western turning into Hardwick village. Go east on the B4449 to the roundabout junction with the minor road to Stanton Harcourt Continue straight over on the B4449 through Sutton to the roundabout just west of Eynsham Take the third exit to bear right on the B4449 to the roundabout junction with the B4044 near Swinford Turn around the roundabout and take the fourth exit to retrace westwards on the B4449 At the roundabout west of Eynsham, bear left to continue on the B4449 At the Stanton Harcourt roundabout take the second exit to continue south-westwards on the B4449 Finish by the road sign 'Hardwick Only' by a double field gate and opposite the centre of the eastern entrance road to Hardwick village on the right, 364 yards east of the start.</p>	H10/18 : Hardwick -

1	Start		Traffic passing riders waiting to start	MEDIUM	Place warning sign before start. All officials to wear Hi-Viz upper garments . Riders to wear Hi Viz numbers on their backs. Riders attention to be raised to traffic movement at time of their start. Riders waiting to start must keep off highway .
2	Roundabout near Stanton Harcourt	2.1 and 7.7 miles	Traffic approaching RAB from Stanton Harcourt being unaware of cycling event	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on road approaching RAB from Stanton Harcourt to alert drivers.
3	Roundabout near Eynsham	4.4 and 5.4 miles	Traffic approaching roundabout from Station Road being unaware of cycling event.	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on Station Road approaching RAB to alert drivers.
4	Roundabout near Eynsham (Turn)	4.9 miles	Traffic approaching roundabout from all roads being unaware of cycling event.	MEDIUM	Place warning signs on all three roads approaching RAB to alert drivers
	Finish	10 miles	Danger from passing vehicles	LOW	All officials to wear Hi-Viz upper garments . Riders to continue past finish without stopping . A finish chequer board or flag is to be displayed at finish. It must be fixed to ensure it is not affected by passing traffic.
	Wherever placing or removing signs		Danger from passing vehicles	MEDIUM	Be very vigilant of traffic conditions It is strongly recommended that sign erectors wear Hi-Viz upper garments complying with BS EN 1150, BS EN 471 or ISO EN 20471:2013
